



LIBRARY NEWS

WHY DO MY RETURNED ITEMS STILL SHOW UP AS CHECKED OUT ON MY RECORD?

You may have noticed that items you've checked out show up on your record as still checked out to you for seven days after you've returned them. Why?

Here's what happens:

- You return your item on Monday.
- That item and all others returned that day are collected by a masked and gloved staff member and put directly into our meeting room for seven days quarantine.
- For the safety of staff and patrons, we purposely have minimal contact with the items until they have been quarantined-this is why they're not checked in immediately.
- After seven days (the following Monday) your items and others returned the same day as yours are checked in, noted as "returned" on your record and re-shelved.

Please note that NO FINES ACCRUE DURING THIS OUARANTINE

Why seven days? Research indicates that after a seven-day quarantine, the virus is not detectable on library materials.


Story Times
